In a short period of time we created partnerships with supermarket chains and restaurants; we have paid dozens of medical prescriptions, we have spent gallons and gallons of petrol riding across the island giving lifts, we have prevented families from going hungry, getting their electricity cut off, running out of gas, losing their homes. We have tried to keep them warm, keep them hopeful, and keep them dreaming...

The Mission Statement of People Helping People is... through social solidarity, to mobilize many people to help many people in a combat against poverty, hunger, illness, exclusion, indifference, intolerance, and social injustice, with a special preference for the last, the least and the lost, having as a model the person of Jesus, the «Good Shepherd» (Gospel according to Luke, chapter 15). Our wish is that it may always be an open door when all the other doors close, building in this way. different feelings and acts of Mercy (Gospel according to Luke, chapter 6 and Matthew chapter 25).

Good morning! Welcome to the Chapel of Our Lady of Penha de França. The 10am Mass this morning will be celebrated by Fr. Joseph Arun, who is a Carmelite Priest, originally from India. Welcome Fr. Joseph! Straight after this mass, at 11am, there will be a Mass celebrated in Portuguese by Fr. Carlos Almada.

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE READINGS

(2 Samuel 5:1-3; Psalm 121(122); Colossians 1:12-20; Luke 23:35-43)

The Books of **Samuel**. Kings and Judges, tell of Israel's history from when they entered Canaan about 1200 BC, up to their exile to Babylon in 587 BC. After the death of Saul, David became King of Judah. In today's key reading David then becomes King of all Israel. He goes on to capture the 1,000-yearold city of Jerusalem, and makes it his capital. He then brings the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem, making it also Israel's religious centre.

The Psalm celebrates arriving in Jerusalem, goal of pilgrims and seat of government.

The letter to the Colossians was written because they thought that angelic beings and other spiritual powers were either rivals to Christ or were needed to supplement Christ's work. Paul says this detracts from the person of Jesus Christ, who possesses the totality of power needed to gain our freedom, "the forgiveness of sins". The hymn praises Christ, who is the image of the unseen God. He existed before all things, which were created in him, and He is supreme over all creation. He has reconciled all things, the whole cosmos, by "the blood of the Cross".

In Luke's Gospel the crucified Jesus is recognised as King, both by the good thief and in the inscription written by Pilate, a Gentile.

PSALM RESPONSE: I rejoiced when I heard them say: "Let us go to God's house."

1. NO CATHOLICS IN HEAVEN

THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING - Sunday, November 20th



Today, the last Sunday of the Liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Feast of Christ the King. Christ the King Sunday celebrates the full authority of Christ as King and Lord of the universe. It is celebrated on the final Sunday of Ordinary Time, the Sunday before Advent. In 2022, the feast falls on November 20th.

Here in Madeira, in the town of Garajau, there is a 15 metre high (49ft) statue of Christ the King. In Portuguese it's called the Cristo Rei statue. It is the work of French sculptor Georges Serraz.

The monument was dedicated on the 30th of October 1927, and

consists of a statue of Christ with open arms facing the ocean. It was financed & commissioned by

the Counselor Aires de Ornelas, who had it erected to fulfil a promise. The majestic statue stands on top of a hill which drops into a ravine towards the sea, and is open to the public all year

round.

The southernmost place of worship in the whole world, of any religion, is a Catholic church. 800 miles away from the South Pole, braving winter temperatures of over a hundred degrees Fahrenheit below zero, a few thousand people live in the Antarctica at any given time. And because, like



most people, they have spiritual needs, there are a number of chapels at various government bases. At the Argentinian Belgrano II Base there is a Catholic chapel with a unique attribute: it is carved out of pure ice! That's right, it's in a permanent ice cave. The first Belgrano base was

built in the 1950s, but had to be abandoned since the ice on which it was built wasn't stable enough. Finding good places for permanent bases is tough since 98% of Antartica is covered in ice. Fortunately, the Argentine government found about a hectare of ice-free land close by, and Belgrano II Base was opened in 1979. Nonetheless, in some ice nearby, people dug out a system of tunnels, and built a Catholic chapel inside. It is still apparently used by scientists working on the base today. Isn't this amazing?
